Subject: Hickory flooring installed on subfloors with radiant heating systems

This technical notice concerns the use of Mirage Engineered Hickory flooring on radiant heat systems.

The Mirage research and development team is currently testing the performance of Mirage Engineered Hickory floors when used with radiant heat systems.

As a precaution, Mirage does not authorize the use of its Mirage Engineered Hickory flooring over radiant heat systems until further testing over a prolonged period has proven to be successful.

According to the National Wood Flooring Association, radiant heating installations using denser species are less stable.
